

Log Limits and Settings

Set a schoolwide limit and require students to promise that their reading is honest when they log above that threshold. Other logging limits include requiring a book title and restricting logging to the past 90 days.

Encourage Student Reflection

Boost critical thinking and analysis with book reviews and short answer activities. Require a minimum character count for reviews and approve submissions for other students to view.
