## A Mark Oshiro Reading Challenge

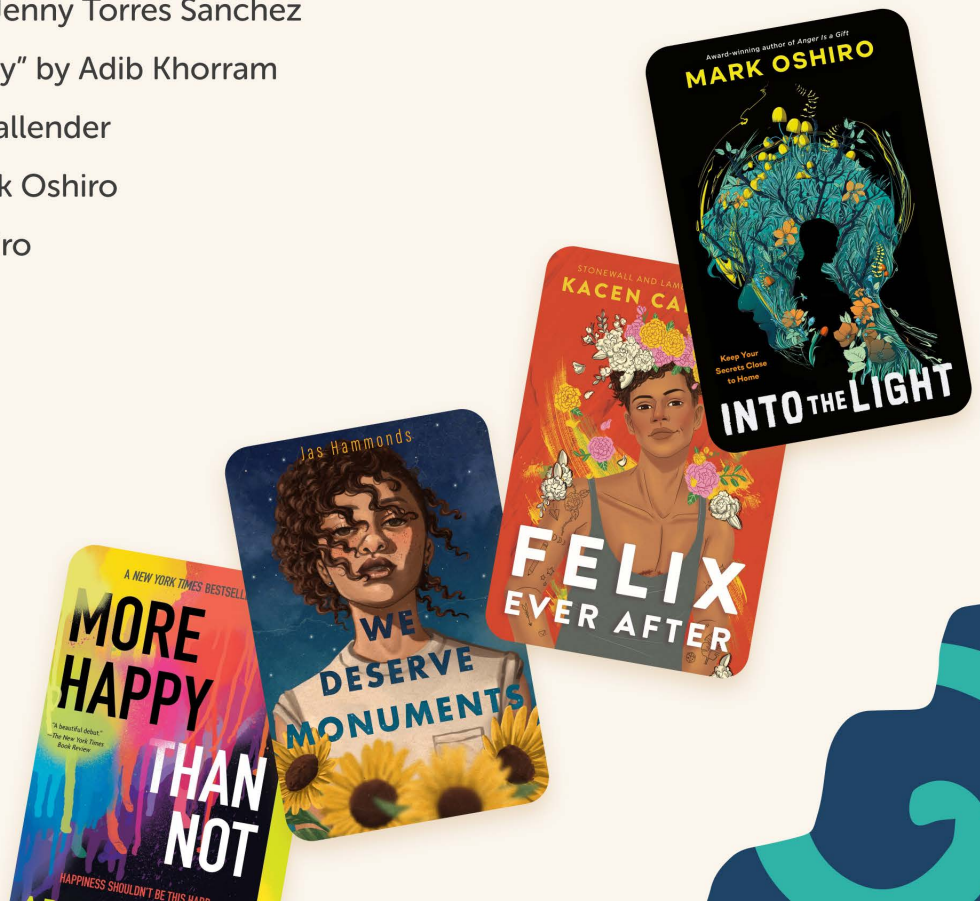
