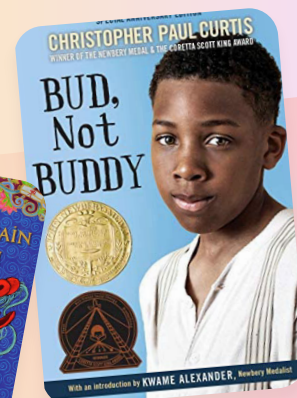
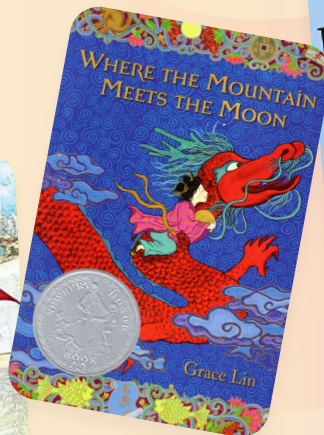
A Grace Lin Reading Challenge
